### **Swanswell start new alcohol advice and support clinic in Nuneaton**

29 July, Rugby –Swanswell, a national charity that helps people overcome drug, alcohol and other problem behaviour, started the clinic to bring their service to more people who need it.

Held every Thursday 9.30am – 12noon at the GP Led Health Centre, Ramsden Avenue, Camp Hill, Swanswell welcome anyone who needs to talk about their alcohol use, they don't even need to be registered to the surgery. During the clinic, Swanswell assess peoples' needs and provide advice and support specifically for them.

Angela Barron, Swanswell Substance Misuse Worker, said:

*'Since opening the service we've seen a lot of people coming forward who haven't had access to an alcohol service for years. We've introduced allocated appointments in the afternoon for those who want ongoing support to reduce their drinking or need help to access other services.'*
